

## Wilson Boulevard Extension Corridor Study Public Information Meeting

Monday, June 27, 2022 5 p.m. to 7 p.m.

All interested members of the public are invited to attend a public information meeting on the Wilson Boulevard Extension Corridor Study from 5 to 7 p.m., Monday, June 27 at the University of Florida/IFAS Extension Office (Multi-purpose Room), 14700 Immokalee Road, Naples, Florida 34120. The meeting will be conducted in an informal, open house setting with no formal presentation. You may attend at any time during the two-hour time frame to review the project displays and talk one-on-one with the project team regarding any questions. (A diagram showing the study location and public meeting location is below.)

The study's goal is to determine a preferred corridor alignment and specifications to connect Golden Gate Boulevard E and Collier Boulevard for improved: access between neighborhoods/destinations; roadway network connectivity; and emergency response. In 2005, a previous Wilson Boulevard Extension Corridor Study identified three corridors for further evaluation that resulted in near-term and long-term recommendations. This new study plans to build on the previous study by looking at county-owned property to facilitate corridor development and assess environmental impacts, as well as land use and funding/implementation.

Two additional public meetings will be held to provide updates on the progress and recommendations. Final recommendations are anticipated to be available later this fall.

Two or more members of the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) may be present and participate at this meeting. The subject matter of this meeting may be an item for discussion and action at a future BCC meeting.
