Using the GMD Public Portal Address Picker

What does the Address Picker do?

- Adds the location (street address or Parcel Number) for the work described in your application.
- Adds the Property Ownership information for the location chosen.

Why is the way an address is designed and formatted important?


- Collier County carefully manages assigning and formatting addresses to make sure that Emergency Services (Fire, Police, etc.) can find you!
- For communities and buildings with common/shared areas (lobbies, garages, community centers, mail kiosks, etc.), we assign addresses to these structures along with addressing the residential or business units.

As Collier County continues the transition to paperless permitting, the next step will be eliminating the paper applications.

Where the proposed work is to be done will change how you use the *Address Picker*

Single Family Residence Address

- Type in the street number followed by a space.
 The drop-down list will show the first 20 matches.
- Not there? Start typing the street name.
 - Stop Typing when you see your address in the drop-down list.
 - Click on the address in the drop-down list.
- Still not there? Click on the Blue "Can't find address" link.
 - Fill in what information you have, then click the *Use This Location* button.



In a new development, addresses are not assigned until the final Plat is "recorded ". A plat is a map of a particular neighborhood, subdivision or tract of land, detailing where the original surveyors established property lines and separated each parcel or lot.

Where the proposed work is to be done will change how you use the *Address Picker*

Multi Family Residence or Commercial Unit Address

- Type in the street number followed by a space, then start typing the street name.
 - Stop typing when your address shows in the drop-down list. Click on it in the drop-down to select.
- Don't see the right unit number? Click on closest match.
 - Highlight from the incorrect unit number. (Tip: keep your mouse pointer above the entry box to avoid triggering the drop-down list!)
 - Start Typing the correct unit number. Click on it in the drop-down to select.
- Still not there? Click on the Blue "Can't find address" link.
 - Fill in what information you have, then click the *Use This Location* button.

- If you need to add additional parcels, click the Add Another Location button and repeat the search process.
- Still not there? Click on the Blue "Can't find address" link.
 - Fill in what information you have, then click the *Use This Location* button.
