

# FINAL 2023 Flu Vaccination Clinics



The **Quadrivalent flu vaccine** is offered to **all Agency Staff Members, Insured Retirees & Insured Staff Member Spouses of these agencies:**

BCC Government Supervisors of Elections  
Clerk of Courts Property Appraiser  
Tax Collector

**You must wear your name badge to receive the FREE flu vaccination.**

**Insured Retirees and Insured staff member Spouses must present their Allegiance Card at time of vaccination.**

The quadrivalent vaccine for use in the 2023-2024 influenza season contains the following: A/Wisconsin/67/2022 (H1N1)pdm09-like virus; A/Darwin/6/2021 (H3N2)-like virus; B/Austria/1359417/2021 (B/Victoria lineage)-like virus; B/Phuket/3073/2013 (B/Yamagata lineage)-like virus

**PLEASE NOTE: The flu vaccine will not give you the flu.**

**A Thimerosal-Free Vaccine is offered at these 2 locations.**

The High Dose Flu Vaccine (recommended for those age 65 and older) is offered by appointment, 566-7676, at Advance Medical of Naples, 720 Goodlette Rd. N. Suite 500, Naples. There is no office co-pay for this service and the vaccination is FREE for those insured with Allegiance.

## Take these everyday steps to protect your health:

- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread this way.

If you are sick with flu-like illness, **CDC recommends that you stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone** except to get medical care or for other necessities. (Your fever should be gone without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.) Please follow your agency's sick leave policy or direction specific for this flu season.
