



## **CYCLE 12 TIMELINE**

**2023 - 2024**

As of July 12, 2022, the Conservation Collier Program now has “rolling” deadlines. For properties in Target Protection Mailing Areas (the property owner received a letter) the property *may* be considered at the next ranking.\*\*

### Cycle 12A

#### ***April 24 , 2023 - Application Deadline***

1. January 4, 2023- June 7, 2023 – CCLAAC reviews properties
2. August 2023 – meeting with Departments & Divisions
3. July 12, 2023 – CCLAAC Ranking
4. **October 10, 2023 BCC Ranking**

### Cycle 12B

#### ***December 18, 2023 – Application Deadline***

1. September 6, 2023 – February 7, 2024 - CCLAAC reviews properties
2. February 2024 (date TBD) – meeting with Departments & Divisions
3. March 6, 2024 CCLAAC Ranking
4. **April 23, 2024 BCC Ranking**

\*All dates are Proposed and subject to final approval by the County Manager’s Office and Board of County Commissioners.

\*\*Properties outside of Target Protection Mailing Areas that are larger than 50 acres may take more than six months to review, especially if they are seasonally wet. Such properties need to be evaluated during the wet and dry seasons.

**CCLAAC** – Conservation Collier Land Acquisition Advisory Committee

**ISC** – Initial Screening Criteria: Initial review by the CCLAAC based on specific criteria in the Conservation Collier Ordinance. CCLAAC determines if property moves forward to ICSR.

**ICSR** – Initial Criteria Screening Report: includes **initial criteria** satisfied, will include boundary and location maps for each site, descriptions of the biological and hydrological characteristics, a summary of its potential for appropriate use, development potential of the site and adjacent land, an assessment of the management needs and costs, the assessed and estimated value.
