The County Manager's Office provides the central leadership and senior management role in carrying out the policies and directives of the Board of County Commissioners.

Under the BCCs' authority, the office oversees all the county's public services and internal support functions, including managing nearly 2,000 employees who work in one of the five divisions that consist of 37 departments, each of which is guided by a department director who reports to their respective division administrators.

Staff provides information and assistance to the BCC, civic groups, the general public, the media and county staff. In addition, the office serves as a liaison to federal and state agencies, constitutional officers, municipalities and other jurisdictions as well as advisory boards. Additionally, the county manager oversees the annual budget process and makes the decisions necessary to deliver to our residents and visitors local government services that exceed expectations, every day.
