<u>Beach Maintenance</u>: The City of Naples maintains the City's beaches in Park Shore and Naples to provide an exceptional experience for our visitors and residents. The City desires to add \$200,000 to the initial approved \$200,000 grant. Approval is recommended.

<u>Structures</u>: The City of Naples is requesting a 5-year advance of \$400,000 per year, totaling an additional \$2,000,000 in grant funding for the maintenance, upkeep, and safety of the Naples pier. The City agrees to forego requests for TDC funding for the pier for FY25 through FY29. Approval is recommended.

Beach Park Facilities: The City of Naples is requesting an additional \$300,000 in grant funding for the

maintenance beach park facilities of Lowdermilk Park. Approval is recommended.

FISCAL IMPACT: Funding for these amended grant applications, in the amount of \$2,500,000,

The source of funds is the Tourist Development Tax.

GROWTH MANAGEMENT IMPACT: This project meets current Growth Management Plan standards to ensure the adequacy and availability of viable public facilities.
