

Easter Egg Hunt

- Averages 1,500 participants, largest among parks
- Held on event lawn with egg hunt and bounce houses

Trunk or Treat

- Grown from 500 participants in 2021 to almost 2,000 in 2023
- Over 30 Community Businesses participate with a trunk
- Consists of costume contest, family games on stage, bounce houses, yard games

Grinchmas

- Held inside so smaller participation but sells out every year (400 participants)
- Groups rotate from crafts, pictures with Santa and the Grinch, cookie decorating and holiday games





Program Highlights-VPK

May 2024 graduated the first class of Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten (VPK) at Big Corkscrew. The inaugural class had 19 students. Trenice Noel, who was also in her first full year of teaching, scored a 6.1 out of 7 from the Early Learning Coalition of Southwest Florida. This is the highest score among our County VPK programs.

The agreement for the sale and purchase of the 2,247 +/- acres of property at Williams Reserve at Lake Trafford, Immokalee, was approved with all commissioners in favor.

This acreage will be purchased for \$20,770,000, the average of two appraisals. Possible uses have been identified, including conservation, affordable and workforce housing, parks and recreation, transportation infrastructure, stormwater management, and economic development. The Chief of the Immokalee Fire Rescue District has expressed interest in co-locating a fire station on the property. On April 3, 2024, the Conservation Collier Land Acquisition Advisory Committee ("CCLAAC") considered the potential acquisition of approximately 1410 acres of this land for use in the Conservation Collier Program.




