## Take these everyday steps to protect your health:

If you are sick with flu-like illness, **the CDC recommends that you stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone** except to get medical care or for other necessities. (Your fever should be gone without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.) Please follow your agency's sick leave policy or direction specific for this flu season.
