Upon request, all sites can administer the Thimerosal-Free Vaccine.

The trivalent vaccine for use in the 2024-2025 influenza season contains the following: A/Victoria/4897/2022 (H1N1)pdm09-like virus, A/Thailand/8/2022 (H3N2)-like virus, B/Austria/1359417/2021 (B/Victoria lineage)-like virus

The High Dose Flu Vaccine (recommended for those age 65 and older) is offered by appointment, 566-7676, at Advance Medical of Naples, 720 Goodlette Rd. N. Suite 500, Naples. There is no office co-pay for this service and the vaccination is FREE for those insured with Allegiance.

Take these everyday steps to protect your health:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water, especially after you cough or sneeze. Alcohol-based hand cleaners are also effective.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs spread this way.

If you are sick with flu-like illness, **the CDC recommends that you stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone** except to get medical care or for other necessities. (Your fever should be gone without the use of a fever-reducing medicine.) Please follow your agency's sick leave policy or direction specific for this flu season.
