SUN-N-FUN LAGOON HOURS 2007-2008 NEW PARK HOURS

Sun-N-Fun Lagoon will switch to its Fall hours in September. Sun-N-Fun will be open every day thrugh Aug. 26 and will begin weekend hours, Saturdays and Sundays, 10 a.m.-5 p.m. beginning Sept. 1, 2007 through October. The park will also be open on Labor Day.

2007-2008 Hours for Sun-N-Fun Lagoon:

- **Fall Hours**: September through October open Saturdays and Sundays and Labor Day 10 a.m.-5 p.m.
- Winter Hours: Closed Nov. 1, 2007 -Jan. 31, 2008; special winter holiday school break hours 10 a.m.-5 p.m. Dec. 22--Jan. 6, 2008 except Christmas Day
- Spring Hours: Feb. 1-May 2008 open Saturdays and Sundays and Memorial Day 10 a.m.-5 p.m.
- Summer Hours: June 1- last weekend of August open every day 10 a.m.-7 p.m.

Entry Fee Information

Ages 0-3: Free; Individuals shorter than 48 inches cost \$5.50 and individuals 48 inches or taller pay \$10 for entry to the park.

Groups of 20 more less than 48 inches tall: \$4.50/each; Groups of 20 or more 48 inches or taller: \$8/each *Group Rates require advance notice. Please, call the park at 239-254-4021.*

Access to other parts of North Collier Regional Park including the playground, fossil dig for children, walking trails and exhibit hall is **FREE**.

<u>Description of Sun-N-Fun Lagoon</u>

Sun-N-Fun Lagoon is a 6.1 acre water park owned and operated by Collier County Parks & Recreation. The Lagoon is located at 15000 Livingston Rd. inside North Collier Regional Park in Naples, Florida. The water park includes 1-million gallons of water fun with attractions including:

- **Sunny's River**, a lazy river water attraction with a water slide that drops into the river (heated)
- **Tadpole Pool** (Ages 6 and under): Offers unique fish waterslide, swings and interactive water features; Maximum depth of 18 inches **(non-heated)**
- **Turtle Cove** (Ages 5-12): Boasts leap frog pad feature that allows kids to climb, walk and jump and enjoy other interactive water features; Maximum depth of 3 feet 6 inches (heated)
- Lap/Dive Pool: 1 meter and 3 meter diving boards (14 ft. deep) and 2 lap lanes (up to 7 ft. 6 inches deep) (heated)
