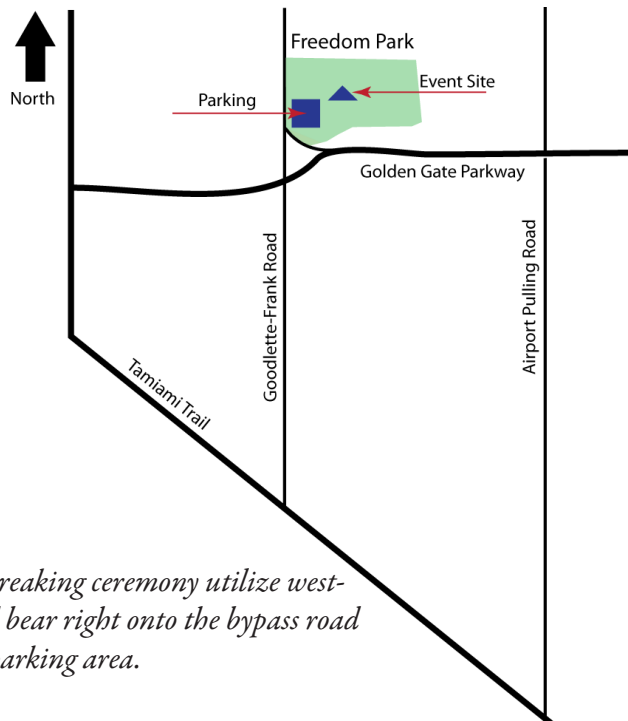

The Freedom Memorial will be incorporated into the 50-acre park that is being designed to provide flood relief and treatment of stormwater runoff from the Gordon River Extension Basin.
