GENERAL INFORMATION

AGE BREAKDOWN:

Individual and partner sports age divisions are as follows:

50 - 54	60 - 64	70 - 74	80 & over
55 - 59	65 - 69	75 - 79	

- All ages are welcome to play, however, team competitions highest age division will be 75+
- All participants must compete in their own age group except in doubles and partner events when the age of the younger partner determines the group
- Age groups may be combined for an event, if minimum requirements are not met
- Events require a minimum enrollment

HOW TO REGISTER:

A non-refundable and non-transferable entry fee is required of all participants. This fee is \$12 for the first 3 events and \$5 for additional events postmarked before January 25th. Entries postmarked after January 25th will require a \$15 entry fee. All entries must include complete participant information, all required fees and a signed waiver. Entry forms will not be processed without this information.

Bowlers, table tennis, racquetball, tennis and softball players must supply their own equipment or rent at competitor's expense.

Additional fees will apply to the following:

Golf:	\$65/person (includes Greens Fee, Cart, and Lunch)
Tennis:	One (1) new can of tennis balls
Racquetball:	\$20/person (non-refundable)
Cycling:	\$5/person (non-refundable)
Soccer:	\$75/team (non-refundable)

WHAT DO I GET FOR MY ENTRY FEE?

Your entry fee includes registration for all events (not including facility fees), plus:

- Official T-shirt
- A chance to renew friendships or start new ones
- Top 5 places in each sport are entered to participate in the State Senior Games to be held in December 2009

AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded to the 1st place winners and ribbons will be awarded to the 2nd and 3rd place finalists in each age division of each event. You may pick up your awards at North Collier Regional Park if you do not receive them at the end of your competition.

RULES:

Copies of the rules may be picked up at the Collier County Senior Games office. Rules are also available.

You may compete in as many events as you desire as long as they are not held at conflicting times. Be sure to check the schedule of events carefully for the dates and sites of the sports you wish to enter.

In State & Out-of-State competitors are allowed to compete in individual and team sports. Out-of-State teams can qualify for the Florida Senior Games State Championships, but cannot advance to the National Senior Games from there.

Athletes will receive an official T-shirt at the site of their first event. You must have a photo ID with proof of age to check in.
