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SDP/SDPA/SIP

Land Development Code Section 10.02.03 B.4.b.i.

A one time, 1-year extension of the 3-year limit of the approved SDP or the approved SDP amendment may be granted. Application for an extension must be made to the Planning Manager with the appropriate processing/administrative fee.

PPL/PPLA/CNST

Land Development Code Section 10.02.04 B.3.b.

Improvements to the final subdivision plat shall be completed within 18 months from the date of approval. The developer may request a one-time 1-year extension for completion and acceptance of the required improvements.

EWA

Land Development Code Section 10.01.02 B.2.j.

Early Work Authorization approval is good for 60 days with the possibility of 2 ea. 30-day extensions dependent on the reason for the inability to gain proper approvals.

EX

Collier County Ordinance No. 04-55, Subsection 2-E, Sec. 22-110(f)(1)

Upon receipt of a written request with sufficient justification, a one-time only extension of the permit issuance time may be granted for an additional 60 days.

SENATE BILL 360

Allows for a 2-year extension of development orders with an expiration date of September 1, 2008 through January 1, 2012. Applicant must have notified the authorizing agency in writing no later than December 31, 2009 of their intent to use the extension.

SENATE BILL 1752

Allows for a 2-year extension of development orders with an expiration date of September 1, 2008 through January 1, 2012. Applicant must have notified the authorizing agency in writing no later than December 31, 2010 of their intent to use the extension.

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
