BUILDING BLOCKS

LOW VOLTAGE FIRE PLAN REVIEW AND FIRE INSPECTION Effective October 1, 2009

All low voltage permits in commercial/multi-family applications will require a Fire Plan Review and a Fire Inspection. This includes, but is not limited to, TV/TEL., security systems, audio/video, and data/communications. This action is taken due to issues found during annual Fire Inspections with penetrations in fire rated assemblies and/or smoke partitions, and wiring installation in plenum areas. Permits received in the Fire Code Office by 2 p.m. will be processed that same day. Permits will be approved via a stipulation letter. Contractors will be required to install low voltage devices in accordance with minimum codes.

Fire fees will be as follows:

- Fire Plan Review fee \$50.00
- Fire Inspection fee \$100.00
