irrigation facilities shall be shown on a separate set of plans. Submittals to be on reproducible product and in Autocad electronic format compatible with current versions on a compact disc (CD).

V. Plant Material Selection

- > Low maintenance and minimum pruning type plants.
- Spacing and quantity based on mature plant development.
- Consider plants water requirements.
- See Prohibited Plant Species or Limited Use List.
- ➤ Minimum Florida #1, or better grade.
- Use container grown material.
- > Soil type pH requirements.

VI. Soils

- Landscape plans or specifications shall require a soil analysis submittal prior to bidding and construction and another of amended soil prior to the landscape installation.
- Finish grade at back of curb to be four inches (4") below top of curb where planting beds are adjacent to the curbing.
- Finish grade at back of curb to be three inches (3") below top of curb where turf is adjacent to the curbing.

VII. Mulch

Organic Mulch to be applied at a minimum four inches (4") fluffed depth with a Grade "A" product.

Finished Grades for mulches shall be four inches (4") below top of curbing pavement or sod areas

VIII. Turf

- Medians with widths of sixteen feet (16') or less shall contain no sod. They shall be contain, pavers, groundcovers, small shrubs and appropriate trees or palms s.
- > Sod areas to be interconnected in the medians when used.
