

Sidewalk Extension from Wiggins Pass Road to Linear Park

- Connects proposed Linear Park to East side of the Wiggins Pass and Vanderbilt intersection.
- Creates pedestrian access on both sides of Vanderbilt.
- Improves pedestrian mobility.

(Depicted in Red)

- Approximately 300 linear feet of concrete sidewalk to extend existing dead end sidewalk.
- Provide safe crosswalk to opposite side of roadway.
- Opportunity to provide alternate access to rear of Naples Park Elementary School.

Landscape/Intersection Crossing

- Raised curb at center of the trail for landscape island.
- Variety of landscape that may include palms, trees, shrubs, groundcover, and mulch.
- Colored raised pavement at intersection crossing to warn trail users.
- Pavement marking depicting trail traffic flow direction.
- Crosswalk.
- Solar-powered, flashing, timed crossing light.

Rest Station

- Designated place to stop along the trail that consists of a concrete pad, bench, bike rack, trash receptacle, and covered shelter.
- Rest areas occur every mile and are located with consideration given to existing grade, shade, existing vegetation, views, environmental conditions, and security.
- Landscape includes low shrubs, groundcovers, and palm trees.
