(Naples, FL) – Choo Choo! Make way for the Spring Festival train ride! East Naples Community Park is hosting its fourth annual Spring Festival on Saturday, March 20 from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. in celebration of Easter with, of course, egg hunts for all ages.

Last year, nearly 1,500 people attended the Spring Festival and participated in the Easter Egg hunts as well as the arts and crafts fun. This year, children will again enjoy a day of fun and games including an Easter Egg Hunt. Egg hunts times are broken into age groups and are 11 a.m. for ages one to three years, 11:30 a.m. for ages four to seven years, 12:15 p.m. for ages eight to 12 years and 1 p.m. for ages 13 and older.

The Spring Festival entry fee remains the same as last year and is \$2 per person. Entry fees cover the costs for the event's activities. Families will be able to participate in the Easter Egg Hunt and all other event activities including the train ride. The event will feature Easter themed arts and crafts, live music and a drawing for prizes. Food will be available for purchase from vendors.

Little ones will get a thrill out of jumping in the bounce house and having their faces painted. There will be a real choo choo train taking kids all around the park grounds throughout the festival.
