ROOF SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

Permit application
Owner/Builder Disclosure Statement-this is required when an owner is obtaining a permit
Notice of Commencement -a certified copy is required if job value is \$2,500 or greater prior to the first inspection. (it is not required to submit for the permit)
FEMA 50% Rule -if property is located in a flood zone provide the FEMA 50% Rule or an elevation certificate
Metal Roofs 1 & 2 Family-must submit two sets of specifications with attachment details highlighted
Metal Roofs Commercial-must submit three sets of specifications with attachment details highlighted
Tile Roofs 1 & 2 Family -must submit two sets of engineering when changing roof type from shakes, shingles or metal to tile
Tile Roofs Commercial -must submit two sets of engineering when changing roof type from shakes, shingles or metal to tile
Roofing Affidavit- <u>Required at 111 Inspection (Roof in progress)</u>
Re-roofs of single family homes built prior to March 1, 2002 are required to comply with Florida Statute 553.844 (Windstorm Loss Mitigation).
New and re-roofs must comply with the current Florida Building Codes
