<p>1. PLAN YOUR TRIP: For maps and schedules, go to <a href="http://colliergov.net">colliergov.net</a> and click the link for transit services. Or call - 239-252-7777, for hearing impaired - 1-800-955-1339.</p> <p>2. BOARD THE BUS - Be early. Double check the route number. Let others disembark before you board.</p>	<p>3. PAY YOUR FARE - Have exact change ready. If applicable, be prepared to show your discount card. Remember to save money for the return trip fare, if applicable.</p>
<p>4. RIDE THE BUS - Seats nearest the bus operator are reserved for seniors and disabled.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Remain seated when bus is moving.</li><li>- Pull the yellow cord to signal that you want to get off at a bus stop.
