The State Land Planning Agency (the Agency) has completed its review of the comprehensive plan amendment for Collier County adopted on January 9, 2013 (Amendment No. 13-1ER), which was received and determined complete on January 22, 2013. We have reviewed the amendment in accordance with the state coordinated review process set forth in Sections 163.3184(2) and (4) Florida Statutes (F.S.) and have determined that the adopted amendment meets the requirements of Chapter 163, Part II, F.S., for compliance, as defined in Section 163.3184(1)(b), F.S. The Agency is therefore issuing a Notice of Intent to find the comprehensive plan amendment "In Compliance." A copy of the Notice of Intent has been posted on the Agency's Internet website. The Agency's Notice of Intent to find a plan amendment "In Compliance" shall be deemed to be a final order if no timely petition challenging the amendment has been filed. If this plan amendment is challenged by an affected person, the amendment will not become effective until the State Land Planning Agency or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining the amendment to be in compliance. No development orders, development permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commence before it has become effective.



The Department gives notice of its intent to find the Amendment to the Comprehensive Plan for Collier County, adopted by Ordinance Nos. 13-03 thru 13-17 on January 9, 2013, IN COMPLIANCE, pursuant to Section 163.3184(4), F.S.

If a timely petition challenging the Amendments was not filed within thirty (30) days after the local government adopted the Amendments, the Amendments become effective upon the posting of this Notice of Intent on the Department's Internet Website. If a timely petition was filed, the Amendments do not become effective until the Department or the Administration Commission enters a final order determining that the Amendments are in compliance.
