EXPENDITURES 9,000 Management/accounting/recording Wrathell, Hunt and Associates, LLC, specializes in managing Community Development Districts in the State of Florida by combining the knowledge, skills and experience of a team of professionals to ensure compliance with all governmental requirements of the District, develop financing programs, administer the issuance of tax exempt bond financings, and operate and maintain the assets of the community. This fee is inclusive of district management and recording services; however, it has been reduced by approximately 80% for the current fiscal year due to the reduced level of activity that is anticipated.
