**Considerations:**

Lee County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Staff have been working on a study to determine the benefit of the long term feasibility of implementing public multi-modal transportation options within the corridor thorough lee and northern Collier County, while maintaining and possibly expanding freight service in the corridor. The multimodal options include running commuter rail transit, light rail transit, bus rapid transit and/or a multiuse path from the Charlotte County line through Lee County into northern Collier County .These changes have been reviewed to addresses the needs of the riders and benefit the community of both Lee and Collier residents. Lee MPO staff will be available to discuss their findings.
