**Request to BCC for a 12 month extension to PTAC sunset period**

**Objective:**

To endorse the extension of the Public Transit Ad Hoc Advisory Committee (PTAC) for a 12 month period.

**Considerations:**

On February 26, 2013, the Collier County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) adopted Resolution 2013-50 authorizing the creation of the PTAC. The PTAC serves to make recommendations to the BCC in matters related to transit policies, issues, programs, and plans to provide mass transit services to the citizens of Collier County. The resolution authorized the committee for a period of 12 months from the date of the first public meeting which was held on July 16, 2013.

The PTAC has proven to be a valuable source of input to Collier County Alternative Transportation Modes staff. There are many upcoming projects within the next year that would benefit from input of the committee, including the Transit Development Plan (TDP), final shelter design, and marketing plan. The extension would allow the committee to serve until July 16, 2015. The request for extension will be presented to the BCC subsequent to endorsement from the PTAC.

**Recommendation:**

That the committee members endorse the extension of the PTAC for an additional 12 months.
