Traffic Advisory

Collier Boulevard (S.R./C.R. 951) from U.S. 41 to just south of Beach Resort Drive WILL BE CLOSED TO both NORTHBOUND AND SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC BEGINNING ON FRIDAY, JUNE 27 AT 7 P.M. AND CONTINUING THROUGH MONDAY, JUNE 30 AT 5 A.M., weather permitting, to allow crews working on the U.S. 41 and S.R./C.R. 951 Intersection Capacity Improvement Project to place drainage pipes under the roadway across the Collier Boulevard travel lanes. Detour signs will be posted to direct both northbound and southbound traffic to Triangle Boulevard during this needed construction work. Access to all businesses in the area will be maintained. Business access signs will be posted. The speed limit has been reduced to 35 mph in this area during the construction project. Law enforcement officers will be present in the construction zone and assisting in directing traffic, as needed. CAT buses will be following the posted detour route. All bus stops will be functioning as normal, but riders should expect some minor delays.
