Beach Parking

Residents pay for beach parking permits in their property taxes and may pick up a beach parking permit at any community center at a Collier County Park. Park offices are open from 9:00a.m. - 5:00p.m. Residents are required to provide documentation proving their residency.

Without a beach parking permit, individuals must pay an \$8 parking fee at any of Collier County's beach parking facilities including the Vanderbilt Beach Garage.

COLLIER COUNTY PROPERTY OWNERS BEACH PARKING PERMIT:

Full Time Resident

- Valid Florida Driver's License or a Voter's Registration Card displaying a Collier County residence address, *and*
- Valid vehicle registration displaying a Collier County residence address

BOTH documents must be original, and display the same name and Collier County residence address

Part Time Resident

- Valid Driver's License (regardless of state), and
- Valid vehicle registration/rental car agreement, and
- Current Collier County property tax bill or current closing papers for property

ALL 3 documents must display the property owner's name

Mobile Homes (if not a full time resident)

• Mobile Home Owners must own the land the home is on to qualify for a resident beach parking permit. Taxes paid on property attachments i.e., sheds, screen porches, car ports etc. do not qualify the payer as a "property owner"

Aquatic Program Descriptions



PARENT & CHILD (AGES 6 MOS - 3)

Level 1 - \$40

The instructor helps to orient the young child and his/her parent or adult partner to the water and prepares the student to learn to swim.

Level 2 - \$40

The instructor gives the student's adult partner safety information and teaches techniques to help orient the child to the water. The instructor also provides direction about how to supervise water activities in a responsible manner.

PRESCHOOL AQUATICS (AGES 4 - 5)

Level 1 - \$40

The instructor helps children feel comfortable in the water, enjoying it safely.

Level 2 - \$40

The instructor helps the student build on Level 1 and to succeed with fundamental skills, e.g., floating, basic propulsion. Must have passed Preschool Level 1 or pass a swim test.

Level 3 - \$40

The instructor helps the student build on Level 2 skills and to improve his/her ability to coordinate motions that use simultaneous arms and legs such as breast stroke, butterfly, and elementary backstroke and the strokes using alternating arm and leg motions such as freestyle. Must have passed Preschool Level 2 or pass as wimtest.

LEARN TO SWIM (AGES 6 - 12)

Level 1 - \$40

Learn to float on front and back with assistance, move arms and legs for propulsion, put face in the water, and basic water safety.

Level 2 - \$40

Start swimming independently of the instructor, on front and back, go underwater, jump into chest-deep water, and learn more about water safety. Must pass Level 1 or pass a swim test.

Level 3 - \$40

Learn rotary breathing, head-first entry, breaststroke and dolphin kicks, treading water, and swimming longer distances (15 yards). Must have passed a Level 2 course or pass a swim test given by one of our Instructors.

Level 4 - \$45

Improves strokes, swim longer distances (25 yards) on back and front, perform surface dives and open turns, and learn more about water safety. Must have passed Level 3 or pass a swim test.

Level 5 - \$45

Refine freestyle, elementary backstroke and breast stroke. Introduction to the back crawl and butterfly strokes, flip turns, racing starts, and advanced water safety topics. Must have passed Level 4 or pass a swim test.





Gordon River Greenway Park

Coming soon to an urban area near you... the Grand Central Park of Naples and Collier County... (drum roll please!)...The Gordon River Greenway Park!

The idea for this magnificent Park was first conceived in the 1980s by the Southwest Florida Land Preservation Trust (SWFLPT), Naplesа nonprofit based developed in 1988 to foster protection. preservation and

recreation along the Gordon River corridor. The first public trail, a 1 ½ mile paved loop along the river, west of the Naples Airport, was developed by SWFLPT in 1992. The rest of the Park is being developed on lands acquired by the County from Naples' entrepreneur Julius Fleischmann's family in 2004 and by the Conservation Collier Program from the Collier family in 2006. That same year, the project was awarded a \$9.9 million grant from the state's Florida Forever Program, under the Florida Community Trust Department (FCT). Following acquisition of the land and award of the construction grant, Collier County Parks and





Recreation Department and Conservation Collier, with partners including SWFLPT, Conservancy of Southwest Florida, Naples Zoo, City of Naples and the Naples Airport, began a six year planning process that is turning the dream into reality. The Park is scheduled to open in the fall of 2014.

The entire Park, including both Parks and Recreation's and Conservation Collier's portions, is 158 acres in size; 117 acres in the Parks and Recreation Department's portfolio and 41 acres in Conservation Collier's. Although the final result will be one large "Park," Conservation Collier's 41 acres are still technically a preserve. All that will be built on them are boardwalks and

pathways, in contrast to the restrooms, playground, kayak launch, and parking and other amenities being developed on the Parks and Recreation Department's portion. And although there are slightly different objectives for the two sections, the final product will meet both objectives, and the visitor experience will be of one seamless Park.



The Naples Zoo and the Conservancy of SW Florida partnered with Collier County for a large shared parking area to serve future visitors. This parking area is currently open and in use by the Zoo. The Zoo reconfigured its entry drive to access the parking, saving the pond and historic shade trees located at the entry in the process. When the Park opens, parking will also be available on the north side off Golden Gate Parkway, across from the entrance to Freedom Park. A future dream is to connect Freedom Park to the Gordon River **Greenway Park with a pedestrian overpass** over Golden Gate Parkway. parking area to serve future visitors. This parking area is currently open and in use by the Zoo. The Zoo reconfigured its entry drive to access the parking, saving the pond and historic



shade trees located at the entry in the process. When the Park opens, parking will also be available on the north side off Golden Gate Parkway, across from the entrance to Freedom Park. A future dream is to connect Freedom Park to the Gordon River Greenway Park with a pedestrian overpass over Golden Gate Parkway.

The City of Naples is developing the southern terminus of the Park, which will be at the newly christened 'Baker Park,' located off Goodlette Road at the south end of Riverside Circle, where there will also be public parking. A pedestrian bridge, to be built in the future over the Gordon River, will connect the Baker Park with the Gordon River Greenway Park.





Features of the Gordon River Greenway Park include 2 miles of meandering, paved, and wheelchair

accessible twelve foot-wide pathways and ten foot-wide elevated boardwalks, two pedestrian bridges, a canoe and kayak launch, a children's playground, two picnic pavilions, numerous covered viewing shelters with benches, scenic river overlooks, a fishing platform, and public restrooms. The pathways and boardwalks are wide enough to accommodate walkers, joggers, cyclists, and skaters, in addition to baby carriages, dog walkers and people using wheelchairs. Viewing platforms located along the pathway and boardwalk will be ideal for birders, nature photographers, and artists.

Nature along the Gordon River corridor is varied and lush. Pristine mangroves line the river for much of its length. Many species of wading birds make their home here in colonies among the mangroves, including yellow crowned night herons, snowy egrets, tricolored and little blue herons. A bald eagle nest was discovered on a nearby property prior to start of construction, necessitating delays in that area until the eaglets fledged, which they did successfully. Other local wildlife includes protected species like American alligators, mangrove fox squirrels, gopher tortoises, manatees, wood storks and roseate spoonbills.

Landward of the mangroves, wetland hardwoods grade to scrubby flatwoods, with a couple of acres of pine flatwoods scattered about. Twelve species of protected plants have been identified in the Park already, with others likely occurring. The entire scrubby flatwoods



habitat, 22 acres, has been designated as a gopher tortoise preserve. A 2008 survey found 119 active gopher tortoise burrows in this area. During construction of the trail, measures were taken to protect



the burrows and improve the habitat through exotic plant removal. This area had been heavily impacted by downy rose-myrtle and Brazilian pepper. Their removal will allow more of the tortoise's native food Protections for plants to grow. gopher tortoises were carefully coordinated with the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission through their gopher tortoise protection and relocation permit processes.


Exotic removal in all areas, not just the gopher tortoise habitat, was one of the first development actions taken in creating the Park. In addition to the downy rose-myrtle,

Australian pines were a major plant invader, with Brazilian pepper a close second. One of the dangers of Australian pines is their shallow root systems, which can cause the tall trees to topple in storms. In fact, a storm in 2013, while construction was occurring, toppled many of the Australian pines in the Park into the river, necessitating removal to keep the river navigable.


All invasive, exotic plants in the Park area have been either treated or removed, and the Park's Management Plan provides for follow-up monitoring and maintenance into the future. Once exotic plants are removed, natural revegetation with native plants is expected to occur. If this does not happen, restoration planting may be undertaken. In addition to identification and protection of the natural habitats, resources, and wildlife in the Park, the County also conducted archeological assessments to determine if there were any historic or cultural resources to protect. During this process, two previously unrecorded historical sites were discovered. The first was a historical spoil pile likely resulting from clearing activity on the adjacent Naples Airport during World War II. The second was a historic site containing refuse dating from the 1920's through the 1940's that may have been associated with Henry Nehrling (1853-1929), a horticultural pioneer in Florida, who occupied the site between 1917 and 1929. The second site was subsequently exchanged with the Naples Zoo for the land where the main parking lot is currently sited and is no longer part of the Park. No artifacts may be collected from Park lands and disturbance of archaeological and historic sites is not allowed.



Groundbreaking for the project occurred in May 2013. Completion of the project is expected in late 2014. So get your walking shoes, bike, skates, stroller and fishing gear ready and mark your calendars to start exploring your very own Grand Central Park of Naples, the Gordon River Greenway Park!
