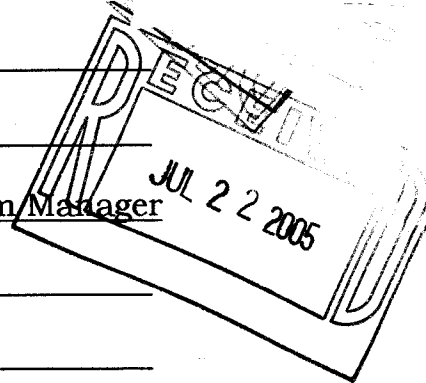

INTERIM – These questions will identify the current status of the project. After the TDC staff reviews this Interim Status Report, if they feel you are behind schedule on the planning stages, they will make recommendations to help get the project stay on schedule.

- ➤ **Has the planning of this project started?**
 - Project planning has been underway since October 2004. The first phase for the permanent exhibit is already underway. In-house fabrication and renovations to the *Everglades: A Work In Progress* permanent exhibit have begun. The first phase is expected to be completed by late August 2005. Bird carvings from Taylor Studios are all to arrive before September 2005 and be installed in the permanent exhibit with additional plant and animal models and information to complete phase 2. The planning for the *Everglades: A Work In Progress* traveling exhibit is currently 70% completed. Various local graphic designers are currently being considered for the banners and information to be used with the traveling exhibit. Bids are currently not being accepted until the planning process is finished for the traveling exhibit which is to be completed by early August.

- ➤ **At what point are you at with the planning stage for this project?**
 - We are 90% completed with the planning for this project.

➤ ➤ **Will any hotels/motels be utilized to support this project?**

➤ Yes, hotel/motels will be utilized to house any out-of county visitors throughout the non-peak and peak seasons. Over 90% of proposed advertising for the *Everglades Nature Festival* and the *Everglades: A Work in Progress* exhibit is to be done outside of Collier County, Florida. Thus, attracting visitors from outside the region to Collier County and the Conservancy of Southwest Florida. By bringing in visitors for the *Everglades Nature Festival* and the *Everglades: A Work in Progress* exhibit, it is hoped that these people will become repeat visitors and Conservancy of Southwest Florida members.

➤ ➤ **If so, how many hotel room nights will be utilized?**

➤ Over 70% of visitors to the exhibit are expected to be tourists / non-Florida residents. The *Everglades: A Work in Progress* exhibit at the Nature Discovery Center will be a year-round exhibit attracting visitors to Collier County. As part of the opening week of the exhibit the *Everglades Nature Festival* is designed specifically to attract out-of-town visitors. It is hoped that the project will generate a significant increase in admissions at the Nature Center driving up to 1,500 hotel nights.

➤ Many of the over 1000 visitors to the *Everglades Nature Festival* and the *Earth Day Festival* were from out of town and utilizing hotels/motels. Furthermore, many out of state visitors not using hotels/motels were still utilizing restaurants, shopping venues and various other entertainment facilities. TDC Surveys were filled out by visitors selected at random by Conservancy staff (See Attached Forms A)

➤ ➤ **What is the total dollar amount to date of matching contributions?**

➤ We will submit the bulk of our matching dollars with the final report and upon completion of the contract. Discussions are currently underway with potential donors and supporters of the *Everglades: A Work in Progress* project. In addition we hope to solicit individual donors to sponsor the addition of future bird sculptures for the *Everglades: A Work in Progress* permanent exhibit. Generous contributions will be recognized on small placards next to the species they have sponsored.

➤ ➤ **What is the status of the advertising and promotion for this project?**

➤ The Conservancy's Marketing and Communications department handled the advertising for the *Everglades Nature Festival* and *Earth Day Festival* (See Attached Forms B) These advertisements were approved by the lead naturalist on the

Everglades: A Work in Progress exhibit, the Environmental Education Manager and the Director of Communications and Marketing.

- ➤ **Have your submitted any advertisements or printed pieces to the TDC staff for approval?**
- The advertisements for the *Everglades Nature Festival and Earth Day* have been completed and the ad schedule has been confirmed. Future advertisements are currently being produced for the grand opening of the new *Everglades: A Work In Progress* and will be submitted to the TDC staff for approval.
- **How has the public interest for this project been up to this point?**
 - Though still in preliminary implementation stages, public response to the *Everglades: A Work in Progress* project has been very positive. The existing Everglades diorama has been one of the Conservancy's most popular exhibits over the last 22 years. Because of the public's affection for the exhibit we have maintained high levels of interest in the upcoming changes. Public support and involvement in this project promise to be very positive and beneficial to the project as a whole.
 - Naples Daily News covered the *Earth Day Festival* which included information regarding the newly added Northern Mockingbird model and the additions to come to the *Everglades: A Work in Progress* permanent exhibit (See Attached Form C). Support for the new permanent exhibit was extremely positive throughout the *Everglades Nature Festival*.

Conservancy hosted Earth Day event in Collier

The heads of 6-year-old Liam Dowling and his brother, Kyle, 4, almost touched the water as they leaned over the Near Shore Touch Tank to get a closer look at the sea creatures, from crown conchs to horseshoe crabs.

Their parents stood behind, at times joining the fun.

"He's moving, Dad, he's moving," said Liam, pointing at a carnivorous conch.

His mother, Gayle Dowling, 39, was one of thousands of Americans who celebrated the first Earth Day in New York City, so when she heard about the Earth Day celebration on Saturday she thought it would be a great idea to bring the family. Also, her son, Liam, had visited the Conservancy of Southwest Florida last year in a school field trip and had a good time.

Liam, a Poinciana Elementary School first-grader, said he liked all the sea animals and the Conservancy. He especially liked watching the animals when they opened their mouths.

"They do a great job of getting children to think about saving the planet," said Dowling.

The Conservancy of Southwest Florida held its Earth Day celebration, which marked the 35th anniversary of the day set aside to raise awareness of the environment and the need to protect it.

The official Earth Day was April 22.

The message is: Taking care of Mother Nature should be done daily.

"We want to celebrate the Earth and make people realize what type of wildlife is in Southwest Florida and inspire a stewardship of it," said the Conservancy environmental programs manager Steve Carbol.

Like many, the Dowling couple, of Naples, is concerned about future generations.

Brian Dowling, 39, said it was sad to see recycling and eco-friendly cars as only a trend that turned around.

Instead buying Hummers and other large SUVs, especially in Naples, people should think about hybrid cars, he said.

Hundreds of participants roamed around checking out the Conservancy's regular attractions, such as boat rides on the Gordon River, natural trails, the Wildlife Rehabilitation Center and the Nature Discovery Center.

Indoors and outdoors at the Conservancy, the event included a load of activities, including an eco-carnival and face painting for children, a silent auction, more than 20 environmental exhibits, a native plant and flower sale, a farmers market and live entertainment.

Saturday was the debut of the first acrylic bird for display, a model of the northern mockingbird, the Florida state bird.

The exhibit of the native birds of the Everglades will be remolded and finished by the fall, said Carbol.

Carbol said they have been leading up all week to the Earth Day celebration, with canoe and kayak rides, Everglades day trips, a birding clinic and cruises.

The Earth Day event also showcased an art exhibition of the work of Clyde Butcher and Chris Murray.

Marge Galbraith, 62, of Indianapolis, was visiting her son's family, and she came to Saturday's celebration thinking that it would be a great activity for her four grandchildren.

"This was educational, but fun," she said.

The \$1 admission cost included all activities and Conservancy attractions.
