

“Control” Structures

- Controls the level of water and the timing of water released from ponds



Checked regularly during the wet season for debris that may be blocking the openings. Some openings may be under water.

Stormwater Facilities Control Structures



Flow restriction feature removed from an inlet.



Control Structures

Trash guards protect the small openings from being clogged with floating trash and debris.



Control Structures

Water should flow from the bottom of the debris shield.
Sometimes they are built incorrectly.



Control Structures

Some vegetation in front of the control structure helps to keep debris away and may remove some pollutants.



Unmanaged, the same vegetation can prevent outflow.
