Long Range Transportation Plan Major Update

Objective:

To provide an update on Collier County's 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan to the Public Transit Ad Hoc Advisory Committee members.

Considerations:


In a collaborative effort with the Collier Metropolitan Planning Organization, Public Transit & Neighborhood Enhancement staff works together every five years Collier County to update its Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP). The purpose of this plan update is to advance a 20-year planning horizon, and adopt a cost feasible plan that encourages and promotes a safe and efficient multi-modal transportation system that serves the future year's transportation demands. The LRTP is intended to serve the overall mobility needs of the area, while also being cost effective and consistent with national, state and local goals and objectives.

The MPO has been holding working group meetings to discuss various aspects of the plan. Michelle Arnold sits on the working group and provides input related to transit. The first phase of the planning process included the development of Socioeconomic Data Forecast, draft Goals and Objectives and preliminary Project Selection and Prioritization Criteria. The process is now in the Phase II stage which involves the development of a Needs Assessment for Transit and Highways, the development of preliminary Cost Feasible systems which will be entered into District-wide multi-modal travel demand model. The attached list represents some of the transit related information with will be modeled.
