NEW BEACH ACCESS ATTRACTS SUNSET CROWD

Many people are already enjoying Southwest Florida's beautiful sunset at Collier County's newest public beach access, Bluebill Beach Access.

Wednesday, May 11, Collier County Parks & Recreation opened the Bluebill Beach Access, located at 100 Bluebill Avenue, which is the site of the recently closed Vanderbilt Inn in North Naples.

The Bluebill Beach Access is located at the intersection of Bluebill Avenue and Gulfshore Drive, providing easy access to Collier County's white sanded beach. The access has 18 public parking spaces.

Parks & Recreation has set up a temporary beach access on the site until a permanent facility is constructed. Once completed, the beach access will include restroom facilities.

If the Bluebill Beach Access lot is full, people may also park at Parks & Recreation's Conner Park also located on Bluebill (111th Street). Conner Park is just a few blocks away from the Bluebill Beach Access.
