		X		Review beds for replacements. A comprehensive project length estimate should be developed.	
<b>IRRIGATION</b>		X		September water use is low.	
<b>WEED CONTROL</b>		X		Continue treating invasive Ground Orchids. Recommend researching an application of a pre-emergent for the Ground Orchids.	
<b>UNDERSTORY PRUNNING</b>		X		Do not prune Muhly grass until after blooms have declined.	
		X	2	All Jatropha trees need to be scheduled for pruning to thin and for structure.	
<b>DISEASE AND PEST CONTROL</b>		X		Monitor the following plants: Blue berry Flax Lily for rust disease and snail activity. Big Rose Crown of thorn fro leaf spot fungus. Caterpillar activity may increase on Bougainvillea shrubs with dryer conditions.	
<b>FERTILIZATION</b>		X		FY 15-16 revised fertilization schedule has been attached to the monthly report.
