tmas Around The World Parade & Gala Instruction on Parade and Entries

- 1. The entire Christmas Parade & Gala with all its festivities will represent the upcoming Christmas event for 2015. Clothing attire is festive and casual. Can staff wear CAT uniform and something festive?
- 2. Immokalee's Parade Route- The parade will originate at First and Carver Street, pass the Immokalee Casino to Main Street, make a left on Main and proceed to 11<sup>th</sup> Street. Turn right and go down Immokalee Drive, make a right turn and go to Immokalee High School football field to unload and come directly across the street to the Immokalee Aquatic Sports Complex.
- 3. The Immokalee Christmas Night Parade will begin December 12. 2015 at 5:30pm. All activities will be at the Immokalee Aquatic Sports Complex and will start immediately after the parade. The Complex opens at 5.
- 4. Gate fee is \$1.00 per person 36 inches and taller. At the Sports Complex, There is a cost for food and games.
- 5. All float decorations must use at least one (1) of the following colors: RED, GREEN, GOLD, BLUE, or WHITE. All float specifications will not exceed 60' long 8' wide 12' tall. Floats this size will carry 16 to 21 persons.
- 6. All floats must have lights of color. All sponsored entries must provide their own POWER SOURCE.
- 7. All floats and float beds, signs, and props must be the responsibility of the sponsoring organization.
- 8. All sponsoring organizations will be responsible for all persons with costumes, riding, or walking with the floats.
- 9. All parade entries representing any organization must have adequate signage on both sides of the vehicle or float with lights. !
- 10. ALL FOOD VENDORS/ CRAFT BOOTHS must sign up with Derrick at 239.657.1951 with Parks & Recreation Office.
- 11. Every parade entry must have Christmas music on or have your radio tuned to La Ley 92. because they will be playing Christmas music throughout the parade.
