<b>TRESS</b>		X	3	Schedule large canopy trees for annual pruning to remove branches intruding into the travel lanes and that are less than 15 foot height over the travel lane.	Median Large Canopy Tree Pruning Specifications: Prune canopy to lift, reduce and/or for structure in order to provide for an ultimate mature canopy at 15 feet above the turn or travel lanes, while keeping any 15 feet or less canopy, if present within the median back of curbing.
<b>SHRUBS &amp; ORNAMENTAL GRASSES</b>		X	3	Review shrub beds for replacements. It is recommended a roadway length complete estimate of all plants that need to be replaced be developed.	
<b>GROUND COVERS</b>		X	2	Remove and/or prune out any dead or damaged foliage in Juniper and dwarf Fakahatchee grasses.	
<b>TURF</b>		X	3	There exist multiple areas of declined or missing turf throughout the medians containing turf. A replacement program should be developed and submitted.	
<b>IRRIGATION</b>		X		Recommend setting 18 turf zones to 15 minutes three times per week and all other zones to 10 minutes three times per week. This controller setting combined with weekly irrigation checks should require a water use per month of 151,720 gal. (+/-). The current October meter water use reading showed 71,367 gal. used.	
<b>WEED CONTROL</b>		X		Review all turf areas for second application of Broadleaf weed control.	
<b>UNDERSTORY PRUNNING</b>		X	3	All Thryallis shrubs should have a 40% reduction pruning occur in September.
