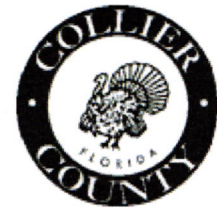

Notice is hereby given that the *Collier County Local Rule Review Committee* (LRRC), established by the Board of County Commissioners to review *manatee protection speed zones* and provide feedback to the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Committee (FWC), will meet **at 1 p.m. on Friday, April 8** in Conference Room 609/610, Growth Management Department, 2800 North Horseshoe Drive, Naples, Florida 34104.

Two or more members of the Board of County Commissioners, Naples City Council, Marco Island City Council, Everglades City Council, Coastal Advisory Committee and Tourist Development Council may be present and may participate at the meeting. The subject matter of this meeting may be an item for discussion and action at future meetings of these boards, councils or agencies.

All interested parties are invited to attend, and to register to speak. All registered public speakers will be limited to three minutes unless permission for additional time is granted by the chairman.

Collier County Ordinance No. 2004-05 requires that all lobbyists shall, before engaging in any lobbying activities (including, but not limited to, addressing the Board of County Commissioners, an advisory board or quasi-judicial board), register with the Clerk to the Board at the Board Minutes and Records Department.

Anyone who requires an auxiliary aid or service for effective communication, or other reasonable accommodations in order to participate in this proceeding, should contact the Collier County Facilities Management Division located at 3335 Tamiami Trail E., Naples, Florida 34112 or 239-252-8380 as soon as possible, but no later than 48 hours before the scheduled event.
