	Notice of Commencement. A certified copy is required if job value is \$2,500 or greater prior to the first inspection (this is not required to be submitted to obtain the permit).
	FEMA 50% Rule-for addition/alterations. If property is located in a flood zone provide the FEMA 50% Rule or an Elevation Certificate.
	Health Department requirements. Route all commercial permits on septic for review to determine if establishment is producing commercial sewage waste. If commercial establishment has commercial sewage flow treated by onsite septic system(s), an annual commercial operating permit is required. Additional permitting will be required for industrial or manufacturing establishments. Provide an operating permit application on FDOH form DH4081 page 1 and complete a business survey per separate business entity served by the onsite septic system using FDOH form DH4081 page 2.
