Volunteer Guidelines and Safety Tips

Volunteer Guidelines

Volunteer crew members should possess the following minimum qualifications:

- 1. Good common sense
- 2. Good physical conditions, including eyesight and hearing
- 3. Mental alertness
- 4. A sense of responsibility for safety of public and crew members
- 5. At least 18 years of age

Safety Tips:

- 1. Park all vehicles on same side of roadway.
- 2. Carpool to the site to reduce the number of vehicles.
- 3. Work on one side of the roadway at a time.
- 4. Work in pairs with one person primarily a lookout for traffic.
- 5. Whenever possible, face oncoming traffic while you work.
- 6. Be prepared to move out of the way of vehicles in an emergency.
- 7. Do not cross busy sections of roadway.
- 8. Discontinue work in inclement weather, especially in times of reduced visibility and wet roads. Work only during daylight hours.
- 9. Drink plenty of water during the summer months.
- 10. Have a refresher session on safety awareness each time a crew goes out.

WHAT TO WEAR:

11. Wear a hat, long sleeve shirt, and sunglasses to avoid sunburn.

- 12. Wear lace-up shoes with a closed toe. Watch your footing. Stay off riprap and steep slopes.
- 13. Do not wear headsets, which interfere with hearing oncoming traffic and other potential hazards.
- 14. Always wear light colored clothing and your safety vests when working in road rights-of-way.
- 15. Wear proper gloves when applying adhesive (see Material Safety Data Sheet MSDS, for the adhesive).

STAY AWAY FROM:

- 16. Do not attempt to remove objects from inlets, especially large objects. If known or suspected toxic/hazardous substances are spotted notify the Sheriff on the location of such objects immediately.
- 17. Be alert for places where snakes may be located, such as around old logs and in tall grass, and avoid these areas. Be equally alert for stinging insects, especially fire ants.
- 18. Avoid contact with poison ivy, poison oak, and other noxious weeds.
- 19. Stay clear of any moving operations and maintenance/construction activities.
- 20. DO NOT ENTER THE ROADWAY Work only from the shoulder area when inlets are along streets.

REMEMBER: STREETS ARE A DANGEROUS ENVIRONMENT – STAY ALERT
