Collier County will conduct a kickoff public information meeting for the Randall Boulevard and Oil Well Road Corridor Study, in Collier County, Florida. **The kickoff public information meeting will be held on Wednesday March 22, 2017, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the UF/IFAS Extension Office, 14700 Immokalee Road, Naples, FL 34120.** The meeting will be an open house format and participants are welcome to attend any time between 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. The purpose of the project is to enhance overall traffic operations and safety conditions to serve future travel demand while minimizing impacts to the surrounding environment. The study team will evaluate potential improvements to existing Randall Boulevard, Oil Well Road, Desoto Boulevard and Everglades Boulevard, as well as potential corridors on a new alignment. This public meeting is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements.
