Collier County has scheduled a kickoff public information meeting to discuss the Randall Boulevard and Oil Well Road Corridor Study in Collier County, Florida. Collier County initiated the corridor study to evaluate potential roadway network improvements near Randall Boulevard and Oil Well Road. The study involves the evaluation of several corridor alternatives to enhance traffic operations and safety conditions based on current and future travel demands. The study will evaluate potential improvements to existing Randall Boulevard, Oil Well Road, Desoto Boulevard and Everglades Boulevard, as well as potential corridors on a new alignment.

The Randall Boulevard and Oil Well Road Corridor Study Kickoff Public Information Meeting is scheduled for Wednesday March 22, 2017, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the UF/IFAS Extension Office, 14700 Immokalee Road, Naples, FL 34120. The kickoff public information meeting will be conducted in an informal, open house format to provide an opportunity for the public to learn about the project, become familiar with the study process, and provide initial feedback.
