Goodland Drive Rehabilitation Project

Need: Goodland Drive, which is the only vehicular access to the community of Goodland, floods perennially and becomes impassable. This project will elevate the roadway to ensure year round access.

Request: \$500,000

Local Match: \$4,000,000

Funding Bill: HB 3325 by Rep. Rommel

Funding Agency: FDOT

Bayshore Gateway Triangle CRA Water Delivery System Upgrade

Need: This project will modernize the outdated and inadequate water delivery system infrastructure within the CRA, improving water quality and fire fighting capabilities.

Request: \$750,000

Local Match: \$500,000

Funding Bill: HB 3327 by Rep. Rommel

Funding Agency: FDEP

Golden Gate City Stormwater System Replacement

Need: This project will replace failing, obsolete and non-existent stormwater facilities, reducing standing water and untreated runoff.

Request: \$950,000

Local Match: \$900,000

Funding Bill: HB 3315 by Rep. Donalds

Funding Agency: FDEP

Gator Canal Bridge Replacement

Need: This project will replace a failing bridge located in rural Collier County, ensuring continued access to emergency, agricultural and commercial vehicles.

Request: \$1,000,000

Local Match: \$2,500,000

Funding Bill: CS/HB 3313 Rep. Donalds

Funding Agency: FDOT

SW Florida Research and Education Center Upgrade (IFAS)

Need: This project will improve the ability of faculty to conduct small plot research on citrus and vegetables by using current technology, improving capacity and reducing loss from outdated drainage. (The current system and equipment is 30 years old.)

Request: \$1,000,000

Funding Bill: HB 2383 by Rep. Donalds

Funding Agency: FDOE

Economic Incubators, Inc.



Immokalee Culinary Tech Campus/Naples Innovation Center

Need: This project funds a Culinary Technology Campus in Immokalee (50,000 SF) and an economic accelerator in Naples (10,000 SF).

Request: \$5,750,000 **Local Match:** \$505,000 **Federal Match:** \$3,000,000

Funding Bill: HB 2213 by Rep. Caldwell
