Proposed List Category Explanation

A = Those properties that staff will actively pursue for acquisition.

B = Those properties that are of interest, but which staff will not actively pursue during the current cycle. B properties will be automatically re-ranked in the next cycle unless the owner withdraws them from consideration or they are removed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners.

C = Those properties that will not be considered again during the current cycle, and which will not be automatically re-ranked in the next cycle. Owners may resubmit them for consideration in a future cycle.

Priority Designation for "A" List properties explanation

- 1 = Highest priority
- 2 = Medium priority
- 3 = Low priority
