MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION

ATV Ad Hoc Committee Workshop

Naples, Florida, March 09, 2017

The Collier County Parks and Recreation ATV Ad Hoc Committee, having conducted business herein, met on this date at 6:00 p.m. at North Collier Regional Park, Administrative Building, 15000 Livingston Road, Naples, Florida with the following members present:

I. Call to Order:

The March 9, 2017 ATV Ad Hoc Committee meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

II. Approval of Agenda:

Mr. William Coombs moved to approve the March 9, 2017 meeting agenda as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. William Scott. All were in favor. Motion carried

III. Approval of Minutes:

Mr. William Coombs moved to approve the February 9, 2017 meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Mr. William Scott. All were in favor. Motion carried

IV. New Business:

a. Ad Hoc Committee Vacancy:

One vacancy presently exists on the ATV Ad Hoc Committee due to the recent resignation of Mr. Robert Anderson. Interested applicants should send an email to Mr. Miguel Rojas, Jr. of the Parks and Recreation Department at MiguelRojasJr@colliergov.net for further instructions on the application process.

Question: Do all committee members have to be present in order to vote on the choice of the new committee member?

Answer: No, however a quorum must be established in order for committee members to vote and select a new member.

b. Robert's Rules of Order:

Ms. McPherson reviewed Robert's Rules of Order as they pertain to the use of speaker slips, and the opportunity for 3 minute public commentary, and committee member engagement.

V. Old Business:

a. RWA Contract Suspension:

Ms. McPherson stated that a decision by the Ad Hoc Committee needed to be made with regard to whether to move forward with the RWA conceptual plan for the ATV park, or for Mr. Barry Williams to advise the BOCC that the Committee wished for the purchase order with RWA to be cancelled at this time.

b. Report on Seminoles Contact:

Ms. McPherson updated the committee with regard to several attempts having been made to contact the Seminole Tribe of Florida in the weeks following the February 9, 2017 Ad Hoc Committee meeting, in order to discuss potential procurement of property from the Tribe for the ATV park. To date, there has been no response to repeated messages left.

The general consensus of the committee was that the Seminole Tribe has less of an interest in recreational pursuits at this time and the window of opportunity for a partnership has passed.

c. Collier County Airport Update:

The committee addressed Mr. Justin Lobb, Collier County Airports Manager, with concerns regarding a contract contingency by the FAA, which would stipulate that the lower tract of land presently under consideration for construction of the ATV park may be taken back at any future date for an aeronautical need or obligation, if necessary. Mr. Lobb stated this contingency would likely remain in place; however development of the Master Plan is presently underway and this concern may be taken into consideration if the ATV project moves forward with the airport site as the location of the park.

Question: What length of time would be given to vacate the property if the FAA exercised the option to take back the property for aeronautical use?

Answer: Six months.

Question: If the property was taken back by the FAA at any point in the future, would there be any reimbursement of funds used for land improvements made during construction of the ATV park.

Answer: Probably not.

Question: Has there been any update on the Promise Zone application for funding for the ATV project?

Answer: No new updates at this time.

Mr. Lobb was asked about the likelihood of the FAA taking back the proposed tract of land for aeronautical use in the future. Mr. Lobb stated he could only remark based upon the history of the airport land use over the past several decades, which has only involved farming activity. The racetrack presently located on airport property, which is operating under the same provision of potential take back of the land, has been in operation, uninterrupted, since 1999. Mr. Lobb stated the race track location, as well as land adjacent to it would likely be of interest first by the FAA for potential future use, as opposed to the location being considered for the ATV park.

Mr. Mendez stated the \$24K cost for RWA to complete the conceptual plan for the ATV was a necessity for the project to move forward, especially in view of the apparent lack of interest in the project by the Seminole Tribe of Florida.

Ms. McPherson provided clarification as to what the conceptual plan would consist of and for what purpose it was being done, namely a conceptual rendering of the ATV to submit for the purposes of identifying panther mitigation costs, and not that of a final design. The conceptual plan likewise would not provide a final cost determination for construction of the park.

Mr. Lobb stated the conceptual plan would be helpful in terms of the airport and FAA in consideration of moving forward with the ATV park project and its potential land use. Further, the conceptual plan would be helpful in any future grant funding requests.

The potential risks of investing the \$24K for the conceptual plan were discussed, including a prohibitive panther mitigation cost, or ultimate rejection of the project by the BOCC. As well, the \$24K negotiated price for the conceptual plan with RWA may not be available in the future, if the project was temporarily tabled.

Mr. Mario Mendez entered a motion to move forward with the RWA contract for generation of a conceptual site plan for the ATV Park. Mr. William Scott seconded the motion. All were in favor. The motion was carried.

Question: Are there still plans to construct an RV Park on airport property?

Answer: Mr. Lobb stated it was felt that an RV Park would be extremely complimentary to the ATV Park, and plans to move forward with an RV Park are pending the outcome of the ATV park project.

Question: Would it possible to review a draft of the contract with the airport prior to the final version being created?

Answer: Mr. Lobb stated that a standard template; memorandum of agreement or standard form lease would likely be crafted, with special provisions for land use, lease fees, etc. Mr. Lobb offered to work with the Parks and Recreation Department to develop a template of how the lease may potentially read for committee review, as well as for feedback by a commissioner(s), to mitigate potential rejection upon submission of the final contract.

VI. Committee Comments/Public:

Public Question: Has any thought been given as to the timeframe of when a public opinion survey would be conducted as to park usage and overall public interest?

Answer: The conceptual plan must first be completed to determine panther mitigation costs and the feasibility of continuation of the ATV park project. Other important factors of consideration are potential grant funds available through the Promise Zone initiative, as well as final contractual details with the airport site location. Therefore, a public survey was deemed premature at this time.

Committee Concern: Mr. Mendez expressed concern at Commissioner McDaniel voting on the ATV park project due to a potential conflict of interest.

Response: The committee members clarified that Commissioner McDaniel had previously attended an ATV Ad Hoc Committee meeting and stated, for the record, his inability to vote on this issue.

Committee Question: Mr. Westgate reported that he had been in communication with the owner of a new 140 acre park soon to open in Lee County, which consists of a kids zone, tracks, and campsite, who had requested information on potential Collier County involvement and assistance with promotion of this new park, including participation in the Tickets to Ride program, if available.

Answer: Ms. McPherson recommended this individual make a formal written request to Mr. Barry Williams in this regard.

VII. Adjournment

A motion to adjourn was entered by Mr. Mendez at 6:30 p.m. The motion was seconded by Mr. William Scott. All were in agreement. The meeting was adjourned.
