

NOTES:

- HYDRANT MUST BE CURRENT YEAR MANUFACTURE AND YEAR OF MANUFACTURE MUST BE CAST ON BARREL.
- 2. ALL EXISTING MAINS WHERE FIRE HYDRANTS ARE TO BE INSTALLED SHALL BE HOT TAPPED.
- 3. VALVE BOX RISER SHALL NOT BEAR ON VALVE OR PIPE.
- 4. ALL FIRE HYDRANT BARRELS SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF 5-1/4" DIAMETER.
- 5. ALL FIRE HYDRANTS INSTALLED SHALL BE OF THE BREAK AWAY FLANGE TYPE AND MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE LOCAL FIRE CONTROL DISTRICT.
- TAPPING SADDLES MAY BE EITHER STAINLESS STEEL OR DUCTILE IRON. ALL TAPPING SADDLES FOR ASBESTOS CEMENT PIPE SHALL BE STAINLESS STEEL.
- 7. HYDRANT SHALL CONFORM WITH AWWA C-502.
- 8. THRUST RESTRAINT SHALL BE BY MJ RETAINER GLANDS.
