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#### **Project Design and Analysis**



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#### The Survey

- Random telephone survey of 800 Sarasota County residents age 18 and older by Susan Schuler & Associates, Inc.
- Polling was conducted from May 8 May 28, 2017.
- The margin of error for the survey is ± 3.5% at the 95% confidence level.
- The average time to complete the survey was 9.3 minutes.



#### The Survey

- The major focus of this year's survey is determining the degree to which continued population growth is impacting citizen perceptions.
- •Another focus is to discern what approach Sarasota County should take <u>now</u> on infrastructure spending to better position itself when the next economic downturn occurs.











#### Overall Quality of Life in Sarasota County






## Trend: Overall Quality of Life in Sarasota County: 2006-2017






### Relationship Between Quality of Life and Service Quality Rating



#### **Greatest Fiscal Stress on Sarasota County Households**
















#### Single Biggest Threat to County's Economy















#### Comparative Trust in Leaders to Do the Right Thing for County Residents






### Trend: Level of Trust in Leaders at Different Levels of Government, 20112017 (Almost Always + Most of the Time)






#### Overall Satisfaction With Most County Services






### Trend: Satisfaction with Services Provided by Sarasota County Government,













### Trend: Citizen Contacting of County Offices or Officials, 1995-2017






#### Trend: Reason for Contacting the County Offices/Officials, 2007-2017








#### Preferred Approach to Annual County Budget






#### Citizen Budget Preference: Revenue and Service Levels





Some residents believe that the spending priorities of the Sarasota County government are about right. Others believe that the County needs to reprioritize its budget. Which view comes closest to your own?






### Trend: View of the County's Spending Priorities, 2003-2017






# Why Does Budget Need to be Reprioritized? (Respondents Who Believe County Budget Needs Reprioritizing)








