Section 301.3 - Investigating requirements with input from the swimming pool industry; may have conflicting regulations as a pool pump is only allowed 1 foot above pool water level.

Section 3.01.2 - Ensure it provides enough direction for structures to be elevated in the unnumbered A zones.

Section 304.6 – Update references. Staff investigating other concerns – i.e. requiring generator above 1<sup>st</sup> floor elevation when floodwater may inundate 1<sup>st</sup> floor and generator activates creating a safety hazard.

Section 3.07.2 - Delete the wording “and parking of vehicles.”

Section 3.07.2/3 – Staff is reviewing the requirements for structures in coastal high hazard areas, i.e. evaluating conversions of enclosed areas to habitable space and will provide examples at future meeting outlining concerns and any remedies proposed to address the issue.
