Kris, there are two peer-reviewed panther studies by panther biologists...as has been referred to in my comments and others. Thank you for pointing out that you don't have a copy of these. I had understood that the Conservancy had sent a copy to the County a while ago.

1. One is Randy Kautz et al. 2006. How Much is Enough? Landscape Scale Conservation for the Florida Panther.

This study is relied upon in both the 2009 Report by the Florida Panther Technical Review Team and by the 2008 US FWS Florida Panther Recovery Plan Third Revision.

I googled the above: Kautz 2006 How Much is Enough? Landscape Scale Conservation for the Florida Panther, and got the pdf version below. I'm not good with figuring out how to attach the study. I also couldn't figure out how to download.
