## **Pepper Ranch Campground Information and Rules**

- The Pepper Ranch Campground is open for tent camping only November 2, 2018 through June 30, 2019 on Friday and Saturday nights. The campground will be closed for public hunting weekends.
- Regular campsites are tent only with a limit of 6 people and two tents @ \$18 per site/per night.
- A group campsite is available for groups up to 50 people- \$50 per night non-profit groups or \$100 per night (port-a-potty only, no water at this site)
- Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. and check-out time is 12:00 p.m.

## Campers and preserve visitors are subject to rules listed in Collier County Ordinance No. 2011-38 as amended, some of which are listed below.

- No feeding or harassing wildlife. Keep food locked in vehicles. All garbage must be disposed of in bear-proof receptacles.
- The collection, destruction or disturbance of plants, animals and County property is prohibited. Do not tie rope or chain around trees.
- Pets are not permitted due to high predator populations.
- Fires are allowed in designated areas only. Do not leave campfires unattended.
- Fireworks are prohibited.
- Hunting is only allowed during scheduled hunts with a valid Pepper Ranch Preserve Hunt Permit.
- Alcoholic beverage consumption is prohibited.
- Firewood is <u>not</u> available on-site for purchase.
- Smoking is prohibited on hiking trails and in picnic areas.
