Phase 1 Development

- Between April 2005 and April 2009, most of the work performed at Ave Maria has been by local companies.
- The project has been a significant source of work for many.
 - During Phase 1 development, the average number of workers at Ave Maria was over 500.
 - At peak there were over 2,500 workers.
 - Today there still are over 300 workers on various projects every day.
- Over 100 different consultants, contractors, subcontractors, and other vendors have worked on Ave Maria.







- Current population is approximately 6,000.

- Ave Maria has been ranked as one of the Top 40 Selling Master Planned Communities in the United States for past 3 years.




