Proposed Work and Purpose:	Removed and replaced metal siding, doors, structural components, storage tanks, building materials, vehicles and miscellaneous equipment. Minimization of flood hazard achieved through the terminal building's location above the BFE and repair of the hangar doors and breakaway panels to codes and standards.
Project Alternatives:	The alternative that has been considered is the no action alternative. This alternative is not feasible as it would adversely impact social and economic resources for the community. Alternate locations outside of the floodplain were not considered as there were no feasible locations that would meet the needs of the community.
