AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPRE-HENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 20 -DEFINITIONS BY CHANGING THE LANGUAGE OF "PURLIC SERVICE SIGNS" AND "LOT MEASUREMENT, WIDTH"; AND BY • PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida:

## SECTION ONE:

Section 20 of the Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Ordinance 82-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

## \*\*\*\*\*

LOT MEASUREMENT, WIDTH: Width of a lot shall be considered to be the average distance between straight lines connecting front and rear lot lines at each side of the lot, measured as straight lines between the foremost points of the side lot lines in front (where they intersect with the street line) and the rearmost points of the side lot lines in the rear, provided however, that the width between the side lines at their foremost points in the front shall not be less than eighty (80%) percent of the required lot width, except in the case of lots on the turning circle of a cul-de-sac when the 80% requirement shall not apply.

PUBLIC SERVICE SIGN: A sign designed to render a public service such as, but not limited to, "time ando temperature" signs and-flashing-news-signs r Such signs may not include any advertising whatsoever on them unless such advertising complies with all of the requirements of this Ordinance.

## SECTION TWO:

This Ordinance shall become effective upon notice that it has been received by the Office of the Secretary of State.
