AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPRE-  
HENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED  
AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 7.27-(PUD  
DISTRICT) BY ADDING LANGUAGE CONCERNING ABUTTING  
PROPERTIES ON INTERVENING STREETS; AND BY PROVIDING  
AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of County Commissioners of  
Collier County, Florida:

SECTION ONE:

Section 7.27f of the Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Ordinance  
82-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(16) For purposes of this Section, abutting properties  
may have a boundary line or portion of a boundary  
line in common with an intervening public street.


