AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 82-2, THE COMPRE-HENSIVE ZONING REGULATIONS FOR THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF COLLIER COUNTY BY AMENDING SECTION 9.8 -AUTOMOBILE SERVICE STATIONS BY REQUIRING CONVEN-IENCE STORES TO COMPLY WITH ALL PARAGRAPHS OF THIS SECTION; AND BY PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION ONE:

Section 9.8 of the Zoning Ordinance of Collier County, Ordinance 82--2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

c. Convenience grocery stores selling motor fuel must conform with 8+a-3++4+and-5+ all paragraphs of this Section 9.8.
